NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY ADMINISTRATION:

ALL OF THE FOLLOWING MAY CONTRIBUTE TO FIRE HAZARDS AND ENDANGER OCCUPANTS OF MOTORHOME OF DEATH, THESE REVELATIONS OF UN SAFE CONSTRUCTION ARE THE OBVIOUS, WITH OTHERS NOTED OF LETTER TO YOU ON 7-21-06, OTHERS MAY EXIST; ALL THAT IS NOTED SHOULD BE SCRUTINIZED FOR CONSUMER PROTECTION.

THE LP GAS FURNACE COMPARTMENT ON INTERIOR OF COACH WHERE GAS FURNACE COMBUSTION CHAMBER PLACED IS LOOSLY LINED WITH NON FITTING PIECES OF DRYWALL EXPOSING WOOD, VINYL FLOORING; ONE PIECE OF DRYWALL DECIDLY STAPLED HAS FALLEN LEAVING COMBUSTIBLES EXPOSED.

ELECTRICAL 110 VOLT LINE AND HEAVY COACH AMP LINE EXPOSED, LOOSLY PLACED UNDER COACH WOOD FLOOR FLAMABLE PLASTIC COVERED ON TOP, BOTTOM COVERED WITH 1/8" FLAMABLE WOOD PANELING, NO TYPE OF CONDUIT USED.

THE PLACEMENT OF ELECTRICAL BREAKERS, FUSES, ALL MAIN HEAVY ELECTRICAL LINE JUNCTION LOCATION ALONG WITH CONVERTER BOX (WHICH NEEDS AIR TO COOL) ALL PLACED UNDER REAR BEDROOM BED, THIS LOCATION IS ENCLOSED WITHOUT MUCH FRESH AIR TO CIRCULATE; FURNACE HEATER DUCTS ALSO IN THIS CONFINED LOCATION, ALL THE ABOVE PLACED UNDER SLEEPING QUARTERS, A VERY DANGEROUS PLACEMENT.

A WASTE WATER HOLDING TANK PLUMBING VENT IS VENTED INTO THE REAR BEDROOM INTERIOR UNDER THE BED, SAME LOCATION AS ELECTRIC WIRES JUNCTION, PROBABLY ODORS WILL SMELL INTERIOR, IMAGINE!

YOUR HELP IS URGENTLY NEEDED TO STOP THE BUYING PUBLIC FROM BEING PLACED AT A DEATH RISK.

Our next phone call was to the Jeep Brake Settlement Claims Administrator 1-866-817-6522 referenced in the settlement notice to ask how someone should pursue reimbursement for work done under our situation. The person we talked to there told us our situation was not covered under the class action settlement but that we should call Daimler Chrysler at 1-800-992-1997 to request reimbursement.

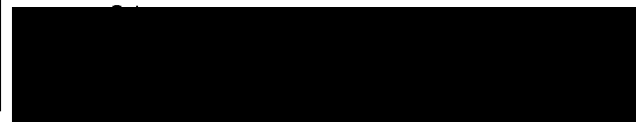
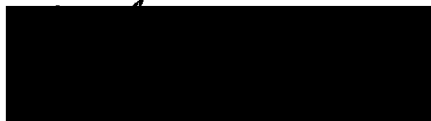
Our phone call the Daimler Chrysler resulted in our talking to Glenis (N16) and she told us to send a letter explaining our situation along with the original service invoice for the work performed and the original proof of payment (credit card receipt) and MAYBE WE'LL GET REIMBURSED. We asked if there was anyone we could call to follow up on the letter because of the apparent uncertainty of the situation. She began by saying not to expect a response right away and when asked what this meant she said AT LEAST 30 DAYS AND PROBABLY MORE. When pressed further she said we could call back at the number I just called and ask about phone call referenced # 15215570.

Not being fully satisfied with the responses received from Glenis at Daimler Chrysler, we followed up by calling the offices of the New York State Attorney General at 518-474-5481. During this telephone call Steve suggested that we copy this letter to the Office of the Attorney General for New York State so that they could follow this matter and also suggested that we call the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) at 1-888-327-4236.

During our telephone call to NHTSA, Martina told us to follow through with this letter to Daimler Chrysler and to also copy NHTSA so that they could also follow up on this matter.

Therefore, we are sending this letter and the enclosed materials requesting reimbursement of \$690.01 for brake work done that should have been paid for by Daimler Chrysler as the result of a class action settlement.
