19412 When car is on dark roads with low beams on, the headlights cause the windshield to display a "dark" tint, similar to a sand effect, as the lights move up & down on the road (due to the car going up & down on the road). This sand effect occurs causing the dark or curtain to descend when the car is in a downward position (going downhill) thus creating a very poor vision ahead view. This is particularly bad on curves. Road is not visible with high beams.
