DT*: THE CONTACT STATED THE VEHICLE SPEED AND ENGINE RPM DID NOT SLOW ONCE PRESSURE WAS RELEASED FROM THE ACCELERATOR PEDAL, WHILE DRIVING AT 30 MPH. THE PROBLEM OCCURRED AT VARIOUS SPEEDS. THE MANUFACTURER AND SERVICE DEALER WERE CONTACTED. THE VEHICLE WAS TEST DRIVEN BY A SERVICE TECHNICIAN AND THE MALFUNCTION WAS WITNESSED. NO DETERMINATION WAS MADE.

IN TRYING TO REDUCE SPEED, PUMPING BRAKES HAS NO EFFECT. I SEE THIS AS VERY DANGEROUS, ESPECIALLY IN WINTER WITH SLICK SURFACES. I REALLY DON'T KNOW HOW THIS CAR CAN BE STOPPED WITH THE WAY IT IS PROGRAMMED. THE SLOW RESPONSE FROM BRAKE AND ACCELERATOR INPUT, ALSO MANDATES AN ABNORMAL SAFE DRIVING DISTANCE FROM TRAFFIC UP AHEAD.
