I started noticing a problem with the windshield wipers in early 2004. I changed the blades and it didn't seem to help. A short time later I received a couple of recalls on my 2002 trailblazer. One of these was about the windshield wipers. I called for an appointment to have these recalls taken care of as soon as they had time. I was very excited.. First- I was sure they would fix the wiper problem and Second- They would fix my problem with having to replace tail/brake light every couple months. They fixed the light problem!

The trailblazer was returned to me in a couple hours. They told me they had done what they were to do as instructed by General Motors. The repairman said that I should get new blades and that would take care of any other problem with the wipers. They didn't work any better. They hang up halfway the windshield at different times.

I heard of a recent accident caused by this same problem, where they couldn't see in the rain, because of the wipers hanging up.

I was told by a GM repairman that he has seen way too many come in with this same problem and he doesn't know why GM hasn't had a recall on them.

I guess it will take a few accidents, deaths, and law suits to get the problem with the windshield wipers on a recall.

Please look into this problem.
