AFTER THE ENGINE WAS TURNED OFF, THE HUMMING NOISE CONTINUED. 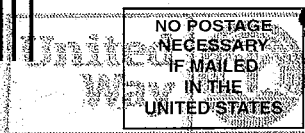

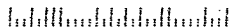
