Ref: Serious Safety Hazard in 2001 S-Type Jaguars

I experienced what I considered stalls several times. They occurred while I was driving on local streets and therefore was driving at about 25 - 35 miles per hour. Had it occurred at highway speed, in heavy traffic or during a turn I, and my grandchildren who were in the car, could have been seriously injured or killed. It could also have caused a serious pileup of fast moving cars with ensuing loss of life, limb and property.

I do not have the extended warranty because I bought the Jaguar new, had my dealer do all the maintenance as per the Owner's Manual and have such low mileage.

I bought my Jaguar, which has less than 18,000 miles on it, to my dealer. They diagnosed the problem and I was told it wasn't a "stall" it was a "hiccup" caused by misfiring by the #8 coil. I was informed that it could happen to any of the other seven coils. My husband also has a Jaguar S-type, model year 2000, which he also bought new and has maintained by our dealer. He twice experienced "hiccup" but his car did not stall (to date).

I had the # 8 coil replaced by the dealer for a total cost of \$322.90. To replace all eight coils would cost about \$900.

Most importantly I was also informed that many S-type 2000 through 2003 Jaguars have the same problem, that Jaguar knows of the problem, but that Jaguar does not want to do a voluntary recall and that Jaguar prefers to wait until the government makes them do the recall.

"How many accidents, people killed etc have to happen before Jaguar does a voluntary recall?" is my reaction to this statement and to the lack of concern for the safety of the drivers and passengers of the 2000 - 2003 Jaguar S-types.

I want my \$322.90 reimbursed, all the coils replaced at your expense and a recall for all other similar Jaguars.
