HIS COMPLAINT IS THAT HE WENT TO THE DEALER AND THEY NOTIFIED HIM THAT IT WOULD BE APPROXIMATELY JUNE 8, 2007 BEFORE THE PARTS ARE AVAILABLE. *JB

The correct Recall notice is 06V-298. Reason for the recall is possible third gear failure of the transmission. I carried my motorcycle to the dealer for repairs, but was informed by the dealer that parts wouldn't be available until June 8, 2007. This is too long to have to wait on parts for a safety recall.
