TL*- THE CONTACT OWNS A 2002 FLEETWOOD BOUNDER RV. THE PRODUCT # 9211460-59 AND SERIAL # 12500059. HE WOULD LIKE DOMETIC REFRIGERATOR INFORMATIONAL MODEL #RM3862. THE CONTACT'S REFRIGERATOR CRACKED AND BEGAN LEAKING. HE CAME HOME AND NOTICED THE ODOR OF THE COOLANT LEAKING, AND TO AVOID A FIRE HE TURNED EVERYTHING OFF. THE ENTIRE UNIT HAD TO BE REPLACED. HE LATER READ IN THE GOOD SAM MAGAZINE ABOUT THE RECALL. THE CONTACT STATED THE DOMETIC VOICE MAIL MESSAGE WAS VAGUE, AND THE REPAIR WAS FINISHED ON 12/2/06. THE CONTACT EXPECTED TO BE REIMBURSED, AND WAS AWARE OF RECALL DATES APRIL - JUNE 2007. *AK
