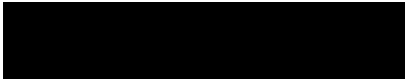

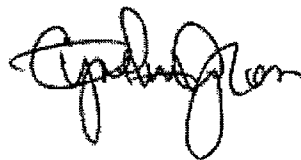

Thank you for your e-mail requesting complaints and recall information for your Model Year (MY) 2001 Dodge Stratus. Your e-mail was received by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation on March 19, 2007. We regret any inconvenience our delay in responding may have caused you.

Paint is not considered a safety defect and therefore does not fall under our jurisdiction. The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) has jurisdiction over non-safety defects, paint, fraud or deception, warranty and dealership problems, remuneration matters, and fair trade practices.
