Thank you for your correspondence dated March 23, 2007, concerning a problem you encountered with your Model Year (MY) 1992 Jeep Wrangler vehicle. Your correspondence was received by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation on April 12, 2007. We regret any inconvenience our delay in responding may have caused you.

NHTSA is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or items of motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain serious safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. We cannot act on isolated problems or resolve disputes between individual owners, dealers, or manufacturers.

We appreciate the report you provided. Reports from motorists are a very important source of information for us. In order for the agency to initiate an investigation, we look carefully at the body of consumer complaints and other available data to determine whether a defect may exist. A review of our database relative to problems associated with fuel leakage after the safety-related corrective action for 94V-106 was performed on MY 1992 Jeep Wrangler vehicles revealed insufficient evidence to warrant opening an investigation into the adequacy of the recall campaign at this time. The information you provided has been entered into our database and will be considered with other reports to identify safety defect trends that may require our attention. Also, we have provided a copy of your letter to ODI's Recall Management Division's Consumer Safety Officer, Mr. Richard Willard. 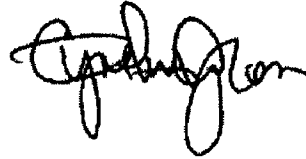
