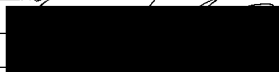

TL*- THE CONTACT STATED THAT WHILE SITTING IN TRAFFIC AFTER WORK IN THE 2001 DODGE INTREPID, HE TRIED TO LEAVE AND THE VEHICLE LOST POWER. E PUSHED THE VEHICLE INTO A PARKING LOT AND TRIED TO RESTART THE VEHICLE 10 MINUTES LATER. WHEN HE RESTARTED THE VEHICLE THERE WAS A CLANKING NOISE COMING FROM UNDER THE HOOD. THE VEHICLE STAYED ON FOR ABOUT 20 SECONDS, AND HE CALLED TO HAVE THE VEHICLE TOWED. THE VEHICLE WAS TOWED TO HIS REGULAR MECHANIC, AND THE MECHANIC INFORMED HIM THAT THE ENGINE FAILED. THE CONTACT WAS WAITING FOR THE MECHANIC TO CALL HIM AND TELL HIM EXACTLY WHAT CAUSED THE FAILURE. THE CURRENT AND FAILURE MILEAGE WERE BOTH 96,000. *AK Chrysler Case # 16095145 (My mechanic tried replacing the water pump, guessing that caused the engine to stall, but to the oil pump. I'm now looking at replacing the car, since the price to repair is the same as a used car.)
