THIS VEHICLE WAS PURCHASE NEW AT LARRY ROESCH PLYMOUTH IN ELMHURST ILLINOIS ON 7/2/02. THE VEHICLE HAS BEEN SERVICED BY THE DEALER AND OTHER RECALLS HAVE BEEN DONE AT THE DEALERSHIP.

AFTER MAKING THIS REPORT I SPOKE WITH ANOTHER 2001 PROWLER OWNER WHO BOUGHT HIS CAR AT THE SAME DEALER AND HAD THE AIRBAG CLOCK SPRING REPLACED ON RECALL. A CHECK WITH CHRYSLER SHOWED NO RECALL BUT DID SHOW A RECALL FOR PLYMOUTH MINIVANS WHICH SUPPOSEDLY USE THE SAME PART AS THE PROWLER VEHICLE HAS 10,100 MILES. PART COST IS \$180.00 PLUS LABOR
