Thank you for your e-mail concerning the Goodyear Wrangler tires equipped on your Model Year (MY) 2004 Dodge Durango vehicle. Your e-mail was received by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation on April 3, 2007. We regret any inconvenience our delay in responding may have caused you.

NHTSA is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or items of motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain serious safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. We cannot act on isolated problems or resolve disputes between individual owners, dealers, or manufacturers.

We appreciate the report you provided. Reports from motorists are a very important source of information for us. Each report is analyzed and entered into a database to determine whether an investigation into a possible safety defect or safety defect recall adequacy is warranted.


We have reviewed our database in an effort to identify recalls associated with the Goodyear Wrangler RT/S P26570R16 tire and found no recalls or similar complaints. Additionally we reviewed our database for any safety defect trends associated with Goodyear Wrangler RT/S P26570R16 tires failing. At this time, there is insufficient evidence to warrant opening a safety defect investigation. The information you provided has been entered into our database. It will be considered with future reports to identify any safety defect trends that may require our attention.
