Re: Safety Recall F23 – Lower Ball Joints

To whom it may concern:

On 2006 you sent a notice to Popular Auto, the financial institution that facilitated the purchase of our 2003 Jeep Liberty, entitled "Safety Recall F23-Lower Ball Joints" in connection with Jeep Liberty vehicles models 2002 through 2006, in order to repair a defect regarding the motor vehicle.

During last trimester of 2006 I brought the jeep to auto service appointment on Alberic Colón Auto Sales in San Juan, Puerto Rico for the repair of the defect on the motor vehicle. They told us that the parts will be arriving within two (2) months but that we should not be worried since the use of the motor vehicle is safe even if the defect has not been repaired. As of the date of this letter, the dealer has not contacted us nor has it repaired to the defect.

We were diligent in requesting and trying to coordinate the repair of the defect but Chrysler and the dealer have been negligent in their efforts, or lack thereof, to carry out the F23-Lower Ball Joints Safety Recall.

Based on the foregoing, by this means, I make Daimler Chrysler, Alberic Colón Auto Sales and Alberic Dodge Chrysler Jeep jointly responsible for any accident and/or personal injury that my wife and/or I may suffer due their negligence in handling the above referenced safety recall.
