In October of 2004 I made the purchase of my first Chrysler product, a 04 PT cruiser. When the car was only 3 days old I returned to the dealership on Sat afternoon because the gauges were dead and the map and dome lights could not be shut off. I was greeted by my salesman who informed me that he could fix the problem. At which point he opened the hood. I started the car made some adjustments, and all was well.

For two years the car ran well. However, the last few months the problem has occurred four more times. At one point I was told the problem was the battery, another time was a loose door pin.

On two other occasions the dome and map lights ran the battery down. And when the car was jumped everything worked again.

BOTTOM LINE I have spent a lot of time and stress, as well as \$237.26 to WOT? fix the problem. And this situation has removed any pleasure in driving the car. As everytime I turn the key I wonder if it will happen again.

I have enclosed two items. The first is an internet search item explaining that for Chrysler this problem is not new or uncommon.

Also enclosed one page from the April 2007 Consumer Reports auto issue. Listing this car as very poorly rated and quality and reliability. But for more insight, consumer reports list ~~to~~ this car as a "VEHICLE TO AVOID"

All of this bad press, ~~one~~ and ~~the stress~~ after 4 trips to the service department, and being told = we can't fix the problem. ~~Big~~ Bring the

car back when it breaks down. Has ruined the experience of owning a Chrysler product. I am not at all pleased to be driving a time bomb, waiting for the problem to happen for the 6th time.

As it may ~~clear~~ ^{is} clear that the car is defective. And the service department has been unable to solve the problem. I am making two request. First you refund me the \$237.26 that ~~did not~~ fix the problem. And second extend my warranty to 72,000 miles from the contracted 60,000. I have performed every recommended service and taken excellent care of the car. This problem should not be costing me money and stress.
