Thank you for your correspondence concerning a problem you encountered with your Model Year (MY) Chevrolet 2002 Trailblazer vehicle. Your correspondence was received by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation on April 24, 2007. We regret any inconvenience our delay in responding may have caused you.

NHTSA is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or items of motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain serious safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. We cannot act on isolated problems or resolve disputes between individual owners, dealers, or manufacturers.

We appreciate the report you provided. Reports from motorists are a very important source of information for us. Each report is analyzed and entered into a database. In order for the agency to initiate an investigation, we look carefully at the body of consumer complaints and other available data to determine whether a defect may exist.

On March 12, 2007, ODI opened a preliminary evaluation (PE07-013, copy enclosed) to investigate allegations that the fuel pump module leaks gasoline in MY 2002-2003 Chevrolet Trailblazer, EXT, GMC Envoy, XL, XUV vehicles. The investigation is continuing; however, no determinations have been reached at this time. The information you provided has been added to the investigation.


