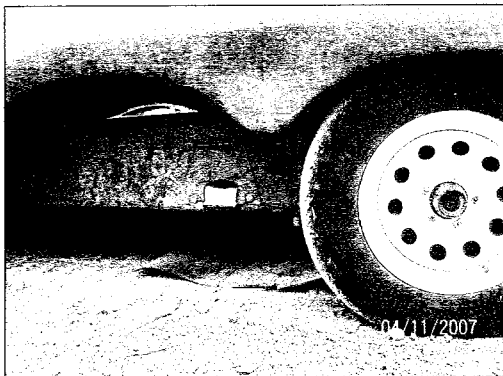

My Zeppelin travel trailer was less than two (2) years old when the rear axle came off. Keystone is polite and I have no complaint with them. The following pictures best show the seriousness of this incident.



There are no structural cross beams so the very thin steel frame flexes in my opinion, and thereby, causes the axle bracket to tear off as shown in the pictures. This thin frame is used on many trailers not just Keystone's brand. My incident occurred at five miles per hour but if an axle dislocates from a trailer at high speed then loss of life and serious injury are very likely.

To repeat, I have no complaints with Keystone but you should investigate before there are deaths.
