WHEN THE VEHICLE WAS TAKEN TO THE MECHANIC, THEY DID NOT KNOW HOW MUCH AIR TO PUT IN THE TIRE DUE TO THE INCORRECT LABEL. THE LABEL READS P245/20R17, BUT SHOULD READ P27560/R20. THIS ISSUE IS SIMILAR TO NHTSA RECALL # 04V221000 (EQUIPMENT:OTHER:LABELS). DAIMLER CHRYSLER STATED THAT NOTHING COULD BE DONE. THE CURRENT MILEAGE IS 50,000 AND FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 45,000.
