AFTER THE REPAIR, THE SHAKING HAS BECOME WORSE AND THE VEHICLE IS UNABLE TO BE DRIVEN. THE ENGINE SIZE WAS UNKNOWN. THE CURRENT MILEAGE IS 120,000 AND FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 118,000.
