TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 1999 JEEP GRAND CHEROKEE. WHILE DRIVING 55 MPH UNDER NORMAL DRIVING CONDITIONS THE DRIVER ATTEMPTED TO SLOW DOWN. THE FRONT OF THE VEHICLE AND THE STEERING WHEEL BEGAN SHAKING. THE SHAKING STOPPED WHEN THE VEHICLE SPEED WAS REDUCED TO 45 MPH. THE VEHICLE HAS NOT BEEN LOOKED AT BY A MECHANIC BUT THE CONTACT BELIEVES THE BRAKE CALIPERS PRODUCE TOO MUCH HEAT AND CAUSE ROTORS TO WARP. THE CURRENT AND FAILURE MILEAGE WERE 71800.
