



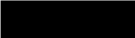

Thank you for your correspondence dated June 5, 2007, concerning safety recall 07V-217. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation (ODI) received your correspondence on June 5, 2007.

NHTSA is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or items of motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain serious safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. However, we cannot act on isolated problems or resolve disputes between individual owners, dealers, or manufacturers.

A review of our database revealed that NHTSA recall 07V-217, referencing rear hood mounting brackets, was the last recall for this safety-related defect. At this time there have been no modifications to the recall. We have provided a copy of your letter to ODI's Recall Management Division's Consumer Safety Officer, Mr. Richard Willard.
