AS OF JULY 17, 2007, THE VEHICLE HAS NOT BEEN REPAIRED. THERE HAVE BEEN NO FAILURES TO DATE. THE CURRENT MILEAGE IS 69,779 AND THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS INAPPLICABLE.
