THE DEALER STATED THAT THERE WAS ROAD DAMAGE TO THE CONDENSER AND THEY WOULD NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REPAIRS. MOREOVER, THE CONTACT FELT THAT THERE WAS NO ENGINE PROTECTION FOR THE VEHICLE. THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 24,000 AND FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 23,000.
