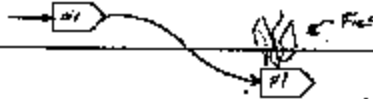

Unit #1 Information -

Damage area - upon officer arrival, majority of flames were present at left rear quarter of vehicle, near fuel fill opening. Upon inspection and photos, vehicle was totalled from smoke, fire and fire department extinguishing damage. The main body damage was apparent on the left rear quarter and rear of the vehicle. Uncertain as to actual cause of fire.

Insurance Information - Policy ID card in vehicle, however according to driver/owner Unit#1, Nationwide Insurance is carrier. Unknown policy number and expiration date.

Fire Department - Milan Township Fire, 2 vehicles on scene.

Ohio Turnpike - Maintenance used, Vehicle #1450 used multiple fire extinguishers prior to officer arrival to suppress the fire which had engulfed a portion of the vehicle.

Traffic Control Issues - Maintenance vehicle 1450 utilized, all eastbound lanes closed temporarily while fire dept. controlled fire. Backup of traffic approximately 3 miles at longest point. All lanes re-opened once Charlie's towing secured vehicle and cleared the scene.

Road Damages - Minor asphalt damage from heat and fire persisting.
