TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2005 SUNNYBROOK TITAN TRAILER. THE VEHICLE HAS KENDA KARRIER LOADSTAR, SIZE ST235/80R16 TIRES (NA). WHILE DRIVING 60 MPH, THE CONTACT HEARD A LOUD POP. HE PULLED THE VEHICLE OVER BECAUSE THE PASSENGER SIDE REAR TIRE BLEW OUT. THE TIRE WAS REPLACED WITH A SPARE. THERE WERE THREE BLOWOUTS WITHIN A 4,000 MILE RADIUS. THE APPROXIMATE FAILURE MILEAGE OF THE TIRES WAS 13,000. THE DOT NUMBER WAS UNKNOWN. NO OTHER VEHICLE INFORMATION WAS AVAILABLE.
