Please consider this letter as notice that, in my opinion, there is a serious safety defect on our 2007 Buick Lucerne.

The problem is that the speedometer is extremely difficult to read in bright daylight. It is very well illuminated at night but very difficult to read in normal daylight.

I have had the experience, while driving on Interstate Highway, that it is extremely difficult to properly set the Cruise Control at the proper speed. It requires taking your eyes off the road and squinting to try to decide what the speed indicator reads.

Trying to abide by the speed limit is very difficult because I is almost impossible to discern what the speed is.

I truly hope that we will not learn of a tragic crash because of the lack of illumination on the speed indicator.

We have met two other Lucerne owners who voice the same complaints as expressed above.
