TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2004 JAGUAR X-TYPE. WHILE ATTEMPTING TO STOP THE VEHICLE AT 5 MPH, THE ENGINE REVVED AND THE VEHICLE SURGED FORWARD. THE CONTACT HAD TO DEPRESS THE BRAKE PEDAL ALL THE WAY UNTIL THE ENGINE STOPPED REVING. HE CALLED THE DEALER AND THEY CLAIMED TO HAVE NEVER HEARD OF THE FAILURE AND WERE UNABLE TO PROVIDE ANY ASSISTANCE. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS LESS THAN 1,000 AND CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 52,000. 5,200.

On random occasions, recently more so, the engine revs up from an idle speed of about 700 rpm, when the car is braked to a stop, to over 2000 rpm. This causes the vehicle to surge forward. The car was checked by the dealer 9/27 & 9/28 of 2007 but they said nothing was seen to explain the surging following braking.
