TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2007 KEYSTONE SPRINTER. THE VEHICLE HAS MILESTAR M633, SIZE ST225/75D15D TIRES (NA). UPON INSPECTION OF THE TIRES, THE CONTACT NOTICED THAT TWO TIRES WERE CRACKED ACROSS THE TREAD. THE THIRD TIRE WAS NOT CRACKED, BUT THE TREAD BEGAN TO SEPARATE FROM THE TIRE. THE CONTACT COULD NOT REMEMBER WHICH TIRE HAD WHAT FAILURE. THE VEHICLE WAS DRIVEN 200 MILES AT 65 MPH BEFORE HE NOTICED THE FAILURE. THE ROAD CONDITIONS WERE NORMAL. THE TIRES WERE REPLACED. THE TIRE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 2,500. NO OTHER VEHICLE INFORMATION WAS AVAILABLE.
