APPROXIMATELY ONE MONTH LATER, THE FRONT PASSENGER SIDE WHEEL HAD A STRESS CRACK AND FAILED. THE DEALER STATED THAT THE VEHICLE WAS OUT OF WARRANTY AND NO RECALLS WERE AVAILABLE. THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 230,000 AND FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 228,000.
