All tires were holding 80psi (tire rating). Then, one at a time, over the next 6 months four out of five tires would fail to hold 80psi. All were fixed by replacing stem. None of the 4 tires fixed have failed again. A failed tire re-aired to 80psi would be back to 40-50psi in 24 hrs. Keystone wants dealer to see trailer but there is nothing to see so I filed this complaint. I am also pursuing this issue thru the dealer.
