TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2007 TOYOTA CAMRY. WHENEVER THE VEHICLE IS DRIVEN, THE FRONT DRIVER SIDE FLOOR MAT SLIDES FORWARD AND BUNCHES UP UNDER THE ACCELERATOR AND BRAKE PEDALS. THE CONTACT STATED THAT THIS COULD CAUSE A CRASH. TOYOTA STATED THAT THEY WERE UNABLE TO CORRECT THE FAILURE. RECALL NUMBER SSC70F FOR THE ALL WEATHER FLOOR MATS WAS REFERENCED. THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 13,750 AND FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 200.
