TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2002 NISSAN ALTIMA. WHILE DRIVING 40 MPH, THE VEHICLE STALLED AND THE ENGINE SHUT OFF. THERE WAS A LOSS OF STEERING POWER AND THE BRAKES FAILED. THE VEHICLE WAS RESTARTED AFTER TWO OR THREE ATTEMPTS. THERE WERE NO WARNING LIGHTS ILLUMINATED AND THE WEATHER WAS NOT A FACTOR. THE DUPLICATE FAILURE IS RELATED TO NHTSA CAMPAIGN ID NUMBER 03V455000 (ENGINE AND ENGINE COOLING), WHICH WAS REPAIRED TWO YEARS AGO. THE VEHICLE WAS NOT TOWED. THE DEALER HAS NOT DIAGNOSED THE CAUSE OF THE FAILURE; HOWEVER, THEY ADVISED THE CONTACT TO CALL NHTSA REGARDING A RECALL. THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 138,890 AND FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 138,490.
