THE VEHICLE WAS TAKEN TO A MECHANIC TWICE AND HE STATED THAT IT WAS INCLUDED IN NHTSA CAMPAIGN ID NUMBER 06V242000 (ENGINE AND ENGINE COOLING). THE VEHICLE WAS REPAIRED. THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 84,650 AND FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 84,270.

The crank shaft positioner failed causing the engine to stop without warning. The crank shaft positioner was not covered under warranty - but a recall was issued to "some" Altima owners my model was not covered. The stalling occurred 5 times in a two week period, and was replaced for \$382.⁰⁰

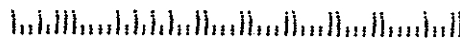
