TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2001 FORD MUSTANG CONVERTIBLE. WHILE DRIVING BETWEEN 10-30 MPH, THE VEHICLE STALLED, BUT THE RADIO REMAINED ACTIVATED. THE CONTACT WAITED FOR APPROXIMATELY FIVE MINUTES BEFORE THE VEHICLE RESTARTED AUTOMATICALLY. THE VEHICLE WAS TOWED TO A DEALER, BUT THEY COULD NOT FIND ANY FAILURE. THE POWERTRAIN WAS UNKNOWN. THE CURRENT AND FAILURE MILEAGES WERE 50,200.

1st incident - 10/13/07 - Driving down Columbia Ave. going approx 30 miles MPH, car died. Amps to 0, trip odometer to 0, instead of mileage #. Radio stayed on though. ~~Car~~ auto shop. after realizing closed, wanted to move out of middle of parking lot entrance. Car started right up with no problems, but pulled off + called Ford. Suggested I tow the car in. They did all tests, checked everything, couldn't find anything wrong.
