TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2001 GLENDAL TITANIUM. THE VEHICLE HAS A DOMETIC, MODEL NUMBER RM3862. THE CONTACT RECEIVED A DOMETIC RECALL NOTICE AND HAD THE REFRIGERATOR REPAIRED IN A TIMELY MANNER. HE NOTICED THAT THE GAS VALVE WAS COVERED BY A PLATE THAT DOES NOT ALLOW THE GAS TO BE TURNED OFF, WHICH THE NOTICE INDICATED AS DANGEROUS. IN THE EVENT THAT THERE IS A LEAKAGE, A SERIOUS EXPLOSION COULD OCCUR. THE DOMETIC HAS NOT CAUGHT FIRE AS OF YET, BUT THE CONTACT BELIEVES THAT IT SHOULD HAVE MORE VENTILATION.
