THE DIAGNOSTIC INDICATED THAT THE CRANKSHAFT SENSOR NEEDED TO BE REPLACED. THE DEALER STATED THAT THE VIN WAS NOT INCLUDED IN NHTSA CAMPAIGN ID NUMBER 07V251000 (EQUIPMENT: RECREATIONAL VEHICLE). THE MANUFACTURER STATED THAT THE VIN WAS OUTSIDE OF THE RECALL AND THEY WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO ASSIST. THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 64,200 AND FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 62,000.
