TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2001 CHEVROLET SILVERADO 2500 HD. THE CONTACT STATED THAT THE VEHICLE STALLED OVER A DOZEN TIMES. THE FAILURE WAS NOTICED WHILE DRIVING 70 MPH. THE CHECK ENGINE LIGHT ILLUMINATED PRIOR TO THE FAILURE. OCCASIONALLY, THE VEHICLE WOULD JUST JERK AND OTHER TIMES IT WOULD COMPLETELY SHUT DOWN. THE CONTACT HAD TO WAIT APPROXIMATELY 5-10 MINUTES BEFORE THE VEHICLE WOULD RESTART. THE DEALER STATED THAT HIS VIN WAS EXCLUDED FROM THE CRANKSHAFT RECALL. THE PURCHASE DATE AND RECALL NUMBER WERE UNKNOWN. THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 73,000 AND FAILURE MILEAGE WAS APPROXIMATELY 50,000.

PRODUCT SAFETY RECALL

SUBJECT: Crankshaft Position Sensor Engine Stall

MODELS: 2001 Chevrolet Silverado, Suburban
2001 GMC Sierra, Yukon XL
Equipped with 8.1L V8 (RPO L18 – VIN G) Engine

CONDITION

General Motors has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2001 model year Chevrolet Silverado, Suburban; GMC Sierra and Yukon XL model vehicles, equipped with an 8.1L V8 (RPO L18 – VIN G) engine. Some of these vehicles have a condition in which the crankshaft position sensor can fail intermittently or permanently. If the sensor fails intermittently, the Service Engine Soon (SES) light may illuminate and the vehicle may run rough. In addition, the engine may stall, and if so, may re-start immediately or after a cool down period. If the sensor fails permanently, the engine will quit running and will not re-start.

CORRECTION

Dealers are to replace the crankshaft position sensor.
