TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2003 GMC ENVOY. THE CONTACT STATED THAT THE FUEL TANK WAS LEAKING AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE FUEL TANK. PRIOR TO THE FAILURE, THE SERVICE ENGINE LIGHT CONTINUED TO ILLUMINATE ON THE INSTRUMENT PANEL. THE FUEL MILEAGE DECREASED DUE TO THE LEAK. THE DEALER REPLACED THE FUEL TANK AT THE COST OF \$1,300. THE DEALER STATED THAT NO RECALLS WERE AVAILABLE FOR THIS DEFECT. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 55,000 AND CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 62,000.
