THE MANUFACTURER WAS NOTIFIED REQUESTING INFORMATION ON NHTSA CAMPAIGN ID NUMBER 05V099000 (EXTERIOR LIGHTING: BRAKE LIGHTS: SWITCH), BUT THE VIN WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE RECALL.
