Thank you for your correspondence requesting information on model year (MY) 1993 Chrysler LeBaron convertible vehicle. Your correspondence was received by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation on February 2, 2008. We regret any inconvenience our delay in responding may have caused you.

NHTSA is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or items of motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain serious safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. However, we cannot act on isolated problems or resolve disputes between individual owners, dealers, or manufacturers.

Our database has revealed that there are no safety defect recalls on the MY 1993 Chrysler Lebaron vehicles.
