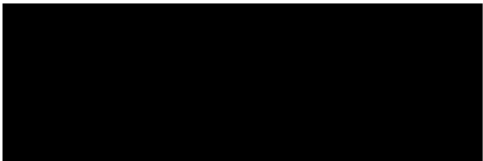
In August of last year (2007), the Ford Motor Company notified me of a recall on my 2002 Ford Ranger pickup truck. The recall identification number is 05S28 and it concerns accidental fires caused by leaking fluid from a switch in the cruise control system.

The repair/replacement could not be performed at that time, as parts were not available. It is now six months later and the parts are still not available! I find this unacceptable because a feature I paid for, when the truck was purchased, has been of no use to me for this period.

I believe Ford is "thumbing its nose" at an agency whose sole purpose is to protect the citizens of our country from dangers that would otherwise be "ignored" by large corporations.

Will there be any follow up on this matter or is it now in progress?
