Thank you for your quick response on my complaint.

I have reviewed the form and made the necessary changes, additions and corrections, as necessary.

I have enclosed a copy of my letter which was sent to the Buick Corp. I haven't heard from them as of this date. I truly believe that this was definitely a manufacturer's flaw in workmanship.

Our Buick Le Sabre was thoroughly checked out by our mechanics at the end of January because we drove

this car 3,000 miles to
Florida. There wasn't any
indication of a problem until
we returned home. On March
6, 2008, our Buick Le Sabre's
engine caught on fire at
a CVS Pharmacy with my
invalid aunt alone in the
passenger front seat.

I have enclosed copies of
the fire department report,
photographs of our Buick Le Sabre
and the invoice from our
mechanic.

On March 14, 2008, Channel
7 News on television reported
that several Buicks from
the year 1997 to 2004 had
fire problems. We checked
on the Internet and found
that several recalls had

taken place. We were never
informed of a recall on
our Buick DeLuxe
VIN # 1G4HP54K4 2/4 [REDACTED]

The recall copy being sent
to you sounds exactly like
the circumstance of our mishap

The Police Dept included their
information on the Fire Dept
report.

Your letter mentioned that
tire problem should also be
reported. We had the car
completely looked at by our
mechanic for our trip to
Florida. According to our
mechanic the car was
in wonderful condition.
We also had 4 brand new

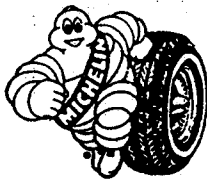
Tires installed. I have also submitted proof of tire purchase and maintenance.

Dear Sir

On March 6, 2008, our 2000 Buick Le Sabre caught on fire. The car was deemed a total loss by the adjuster and Liberty Mutual Insurance Co. Mileage on the car was 93 K.

At the time of the fire which occurred at a C.V.S. Pharmacy handicapped parking lot in Southbridge, my [REDACTED] invalid aunt was in the front seat on the passenger side of the vehicle. The car's ignition was completely shut off. Within seconds of my entering CVS Pharmacy, the car engine was fully engulfed with fire and thick black smoke. My aunt was rescued by a gentleman who was either leaving or entering CVS. Their lives were in serious danger and fortunately they are both okay.

The Police and Fire Department arrived within minutes and they too were, also, in serious danger because they could not pry the latch

to open the hood. The fire pouring out from the engine was incredible.

The car's gas tank was full to capacity and the firemen were very concerned with an explosion occurring.

CVS locked their doors and would not let anyone enter or leave the store. The car was parked left to the entrance door at CVS.

The firemen, however, extinguished the fire and cut all the wires in the engine. Before putting the car on a wrecker to be towed away, the fire could hear a ticking and humming sound under the engine. After finding the battery under the back seat, they cut wires to the battery and the sound in the engine disappeared.

I took photographs of the car and reported this mishap to the Buick dealership in Putnam, CT. (Buick Plaza). They told me and my husband that they had never heard of a Buick catching on fire. On March 14, 2008, several people called me that Channel 7 television was reporting fires and recalls occurring to Buicks from the year 1997 to 2004. Upon this

information, we check the internet and found the information to be indeed true. We never received a recall notice, and my beautiful Buick Le Sabre, my pride and joy, burnt in front of my eyes. It was a terrible sight I will never forget. This mishap shouldn't have happened to me or anyone else. I thought this Buick Le Sabre to last me a lot longer than 7 1/4 years. This is truly unfair to me and my husband.

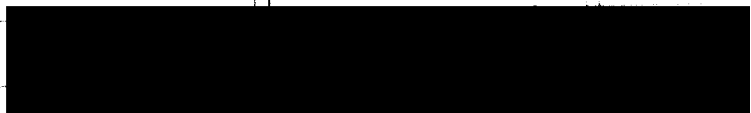
At this time, my insurance company sent me a check for \$6100.00. I am now in the process of looking and having to purchase another vehicle at my expense due to a manufacturer's apparent flaw. My out-of-pocket expense will certainly be over \$12,000.00 or more to get a car comparable to the Buick. Prices today are extraordinary.

I have also contacted the National Auto Safety Highway Traffic Administration Safety Bureau. They filed a complaint to Buick and General Motors. I personally spoke to a young lady at Buick. I am awaiting to hear

from Buick within 2 to 3 days of
this date.

I am extremely sad about all of this
Awaiting to hear from you.

Defect Summary: ON CERTAIN PASSENGER VEHICLES EQUIPPED WITH 3800 V6 (L36) ENGINES AND CERTAIN DELPHI FUEL PRESSURE REGULATORS, THE REGULATORS HAVE A MUCH HIGHER THAN USUAL RATE OF FUEL LEAKS. A LEAK CAN ALLOW FUEL TO ENTER THE INTAKE MANIFOLD THROUGH A VACUUM LINE. IF THE ENGINE DOES NOT START WHEN CRANKED, THE FUEL FROM THE LEAKING REGULATOR AND A MISTIMED SPARK CAN CAUSE A BACKFIRE.

Consequence Summary: THE BACKFIRE CAN RUPTURE THE INTAKE MANIFOLD. THE RUPTURE OF THE INTAKE MANIFOLD CAN DISPLACE A FUEL LINE, PULLING AN INJECTOR OUT OF PLACE, AND CAUSING A FUEL LEAK AND POSSIBLE FIRE.

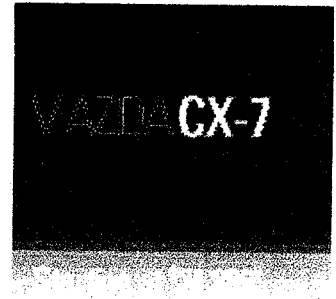
