Thank you for your correspondence dated March 24, 2008, concerning the safety of your model year (MY) 1994 Jeep Cherokee. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation received your correspondence on April 3, 2008.

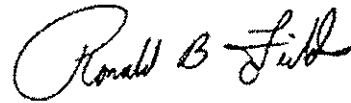
NHTSA is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or items of motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain serious safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. However, we cannot act on isolated problems or resolve disputes between individual owners, dealers, or manufacturers.

We appreciate the report you provided. Reports from motorists are a very important source of information for us. We regret to hear that you were injured while driving your MY 1994 Jeep Cherokee. We have reviewed our database to provide you with data on the air bags, seat belts and seats in your MY 1994 Jeep Cherokee. Our search revealed 9 air bag complaints, 35 seat belt complaints, 1 seat belt recall, and 9 seat complaints (summaries enclosed). We hope this information is helpful to you.
