 Volkswagen Dealers will replace the hazard flasher switch/relay kit on VW /Golf – GTI – Jetta Models 2000-2002 due to a degradation 'of distortion and material transfer of the contacts of certain hazard switch relays which occurs due to substantially increased electrical current load from higher wattage turn signal bulbs.'

I own a **2002 Volkswagen Cabrio**, manufactured by Volkswagen of America, Inc., that is experiencing the **exact** same problem those above named models have. My turn signal and hazard flasher has stopped functioning. Initially it was intermittent, but it has finally stopped working.

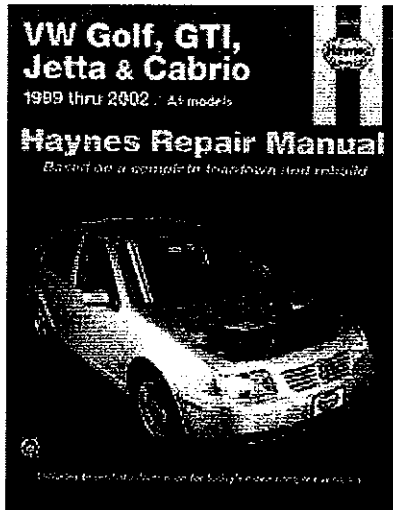
