and collected on a metal shield, located under front of engine.

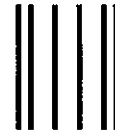

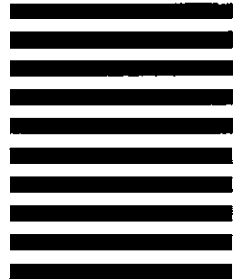

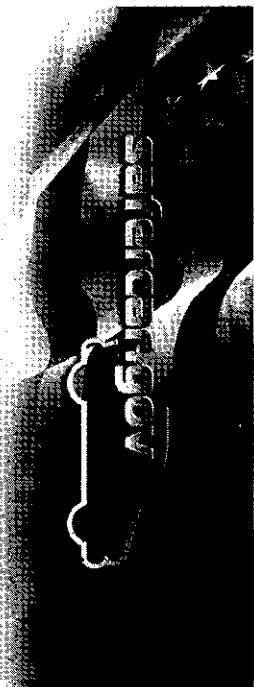
