TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2006 DODGE SPRINTER. THE CONTACT STATED THAT THERE WAS A FUEL LEAK IN THE FUEL FILTER. THE FAILURE CAUSED DIESEL FUEL TO LEAK ONTO THE ENGINE AND THE GROUND. THE DEALER ATTEMPTED TO REPAIR THE VEHICLE, BUT WAS UNSUCCESSFUL. THE CONTACT STATED THAT IF THE FUEL FILTER WERE CHANGED WITH ~~O-RINGS~~ O-RINGS THE FAILURE WOULD STILL OCCUR. THE WATER SENSOR WAS CHANGED WITH ~~O-RINGS~~ O-RINGS, WHICH WERE SLIGHTLY DIFFERENT. THE CONTACT STATED THAT WITHOUT THIS SENSOR, ANY O-RINGS WOULD NOT BE SUFFICIENT ENOUGH TO REMEDY THE FAILURE. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 36,000.

WITH SLIGHTLY TIGHTER O-RINGS THAT STOP THE LEAK.
