No accident occurred. There was a two day inspection by local dealer. They were unable to verify
A problem. I requested a consult with Toyota representative but it did not occur. I did report the incident
To Toyota California.

After two similar occurrences with serious accidents within our county, I spoke with the local sheriff.
He was concerned but could offer no help.

I stated to Toyota and the sheriff I suspected the computer was responding inappropriately to the
information it was receiving. It would be interesting to know the name of the computer manufacturer
In such occurrences, regardless of the vehicle maker. Perhaps there are many such near misses that are
Unreported or occurred under other conditions when the driver could not identify it.

Date purchased 12-27-06 Mileage 2,934 Engine temp cold. Within one mile from residence.
Outside temp 40 degrees F Weather clear Dry streets.

Traveling southeast on Smyrna Road

Passed through yield intersection @ approx 15/hr.

Accelerated lightly, approaching 4-way stop, anticipating turning right.

Engine accelerated @ high speed, unable to control car or brake effectively. Ran stop sign @ intersection

Driver on my left was pulling into intersection but stopped when she saw me.

I was able to avoid her by veering to my right, 1/2 off roadway.

Continued to travel southeast on Smyrna approx 500 feet and get the car under control.

Returned car to my home.

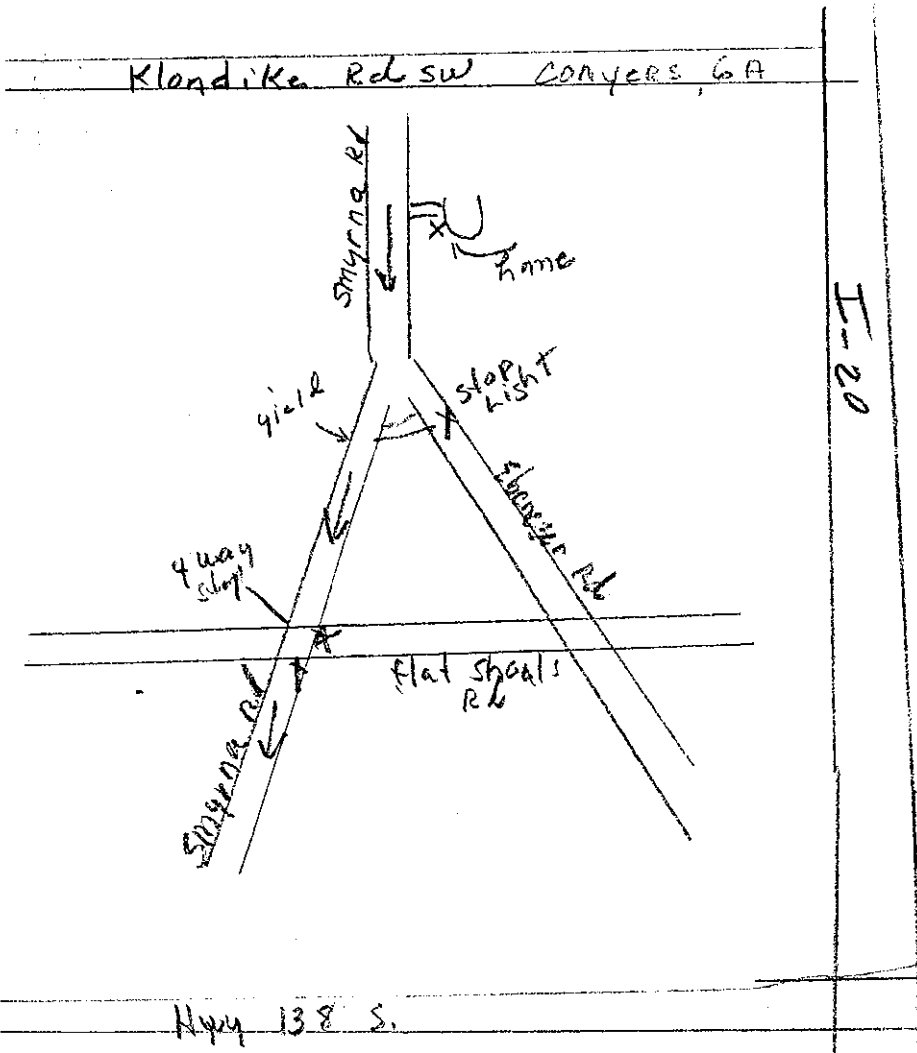
History
