TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2005 KTM 950 ADVENTURE. WHILE DRIVING AT NIGHT AT APPROXIMATELY 25 MPH THE WINDSCREEN REFLECTS A GLARE AND MAKES IT DIFFICULT TO SEE. THERE WAS AN OPTICAL DISTORTION MIDWAY OF THE WINDSCREEN. THE MOTORCYCLE WINDSCREEN WAS ALSO REPLACED BY THE CONTACT. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 25,000 AND THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 27,300.
GEE BAILEY'S, 6900 ACOO ST. MONTICELLO, CA. 90640. I PURCHASED THE SCREEN FOR A MOTORCYCLE TRIP. UPON USING IT AT NIGHT FOR THE FIRST TIME, I FOUND IT VERY HARD TO SEE THROUGH IT DUE TO GLARE FROM THE HEADLIGHT. THE LIGHT SHINES THROUGH THE PLASTIC, THE PLASTIC BECOMES A FIBER OPTIC CONDUIT, I HAD 2 NEAR WISSES B-4 GETTING TO MY HOTEL. THERE IS A GREAT DEAL OF OPTICAL DISTORTION TOO.
