The speedometer shows about 6-10% more than actual speed. There are minimum speeds in places and with this inaccuracy one only guesses at what speed the motorcycle is traveling.

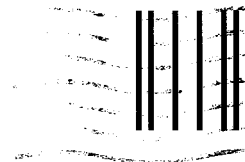


