TL*THE CONTACT OWNS A 2006 HYUNDAI SONATA. WHEN THE CONTACT STARTED THE IGNITION, THE FRONT PASSENGER SIDE AIR BAG WARNING INDICATOR ILLUMINATED INTERMITTENTLY ON THE INSTRUMENT PANEL. THE AIR BAG SYSTEM WOULD NOT PROPERLY RECOGNIZE A SMALL STATURED OCCUPANT IN THE PASSENGER SEAT. THE AUTHORIZED DEALER DISCOVERED A RECALL DEFECT THAT WAS INCLUDED IN NHTSA CAMPAIGN ID NUMBER 08V161000 (AIR BAGS). THE TECHNICIAN WAS UNABLE TO DUPLICATE THE FAILURE AND REFUSED TO REPAIR THE VEHICLE. THE CONTACT WAS CONCERNED OF THE SAFETY RISK INVOLVED. THE VEHICLE HAS NOT BEEN REPAIRED. THE CURRENT MILEAGE WAS 31,000 AND THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS UNKNOWN.
